**NOTICE OF INTENT OF BLECKLEY COUNTY TO ABANDON A  
PORTION OF WALKER MULLIS ROAD.**

GEORGIA, BLECKLEY COUNTY

Notice is hereby given that the governing authority of Bleckley County intends to abandon (close) a portion of Walker Mullis Road. The portion of the road proposed to be closed is described as follows:

Begin at a point marked by an iron pin located on the northwesterly right of way of Georgia Highway 278 and the intersection Walker Mullis Road with said pin being located in the center of Walker Mullis Road. From said point of beginning, thence run 1 degree north, 34 minutes 19 seconds west a distance of 574.34 to a point marked by an iron pin; then run north 20 degrees 29 minutes 40 seconds east a distance of 210.22 feet to a point marked by an iron pin located in the center of Walker Mullis Road; thence run north 30 degrees 45 minutes 10 seconds east along the center of Walker Mullis Road a distance of 2,464.94 feet to a point marked by an iron pin located at the intersection of Walker Mullis Road and the southwest right of way Cary Salem Road.

Said portion of county road is located in Land Lot 55 of the 22<sup>nd</sup> Land District of Bleckley County and shown on plat of survey drawn by Timothy W. Eason, registered surveyor, recorded on February 18, 1993, found in plat book 5, page 342, Bleckley County records.

A public hearing will be held on this matter on 8<sup>th</sup> day of March, 2024 at 10:00 a.m. upstairs in the Bleckley County Courthouse at Cochran, Georgia.

A copy of the Resolution of Intent to Abandon a portion of the foregoing described Walker Mullis Road adopted by the governing authority of Bleckley County on February 15, 2024, along with Exhibits of plat of said road to be abandoned and Notice may be examined at the County Commissioner's Office at the Bleckley County Courthouse in Cochran, Georgia.
